### PRIVATAIR REPORTS RECORD REVENUE ON US CHARTER FLEET

International business aviation specialist PrivatAir announced today charter revenue on four of its aircraft in the first 9 months of 2004 had exceeded \$1.5 million.

The four million-dollar-plus aircraft of PrivatAir Inc. include one Gulfstream IV and a Challenger 601 in the mid-Atlantic region, two Gulfstream III's, based in the Northeast. They are part of PrivatAir's fleet of owned and managed aircraft, which in the United States includes over 40 aircraft in 14 operating bases. The four aircraft obtaining the million-dollar-plus results are included in the company's aircraft management program, which helps reduce the cost of ownership by making the aircraft available for charter.
